Jericho Walk at Burlington ICE

When: Tuesday, June 26, 8:00 AM

Where: 10 District Avenue, Burlington

Who: This walk is organized by Na'aseh, social justice group of Congregation Beth Elohim in Acton. (socialaction@bethelohim.org)

Why: The Jericho Walk is a silent interfaith prayer and act of solidarity. The walk draws inspiration from the Battle of Jericho, in which the community marched around the city of Jericho seven times, causing the city walls to fall. The Jericho Walk of today is a silent, peaceful, and prayerful walk to bring down the walls of our unjust immigration system and is open to people of all or no faiths.

The messages for the walk are "Let Our Neighbors Stay" and "Keep Families Together."
