We were saddened to learn that Rev. Chandler "Tuck" Gilbert, Minister of our church from 1971-1988, died peacefully on May 15th in Peterborough, NH. Tuck, acquired his nickname, when he was born on the Tuck-Wo, a British river steamer on the Yangtze River, China in 1926 where his missionary parents were stationed.
